

AT THE SHARP END

At The Sharp End offers marine professionals, such as insurers, lawyers and shipbrokers, the opportunity to get practical experience and insight into the shipboard environment and operations on merchant ships that they would not otherwise get in their normal work environment.

Our two-day fully interactive course will give candidates a practical overview of such topics as ship types, stability, hatch covers, cargo securing arrangements, container handling, shiprepair and drydocking as well as collision avoidance. It comprises excursions, discussions and lectures with experienced marine professionals to give the candidates a more practical knowledge of merchant ship operations.

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

In the navigation systems and shiphandling simulator you will experience ship-steering and communication techniques, and gain a useful insight to the demands and challenges involved in collision avoidance when crossing busy traffic lanes. We aim to give the opportunity of visiting a ship in service and candidates being shown the various navigation, control and communication systems on the bridge, also walking through the engine room and accommodation will give a real perspective of ship life. Seeing another vessel undergoing repairs and maintenance in drydock will add to this experience.

A fast passenger launch will take us around the harbour. While on the move, a talk will be given to explain the navigation fairways and anchorage arrangements. Notable landmarks such as the oil terminals, traffic control centre, containership berths and drydocking areas will be observed from a ship's perspective and potential issues that vessels may encounter highlighted.



The course fees cover all activities, food and drinks during the day and travel from central pick-up points. You only need to make your own travel arrangements to the pick-up location. When you join the course, protective safety gear will be provided but we advise you to wear suitable outdoor clothing for ship and dock visits. To ensure you get the most out of the course, participants are encouraged to ask any questions they may have, no matter how basic or complex.

Important

Please note that ship visits can be quite arduous with many steps to climb, some vertical. Therefore, it is not suitable for anyone who has breathing or walking difficulties. Also, you must sign the attached HUD indemnity form to be able to visit HUD's shipyard.
