Hong Kong has been enhancing its status as an international maritime center. We are committed to the accelerated development of our high-value added maritime cluster, including marine technology, legal and arbitration services, marine insurance, ship financing and management services, etc. In May 2023, the Government expanded the Talent List, which increases the coverage from 13 professions to 51. We are geared towards attracting more high-quality talent to come and meet Hong Kong's development needs. In terms of maritime cluster, we are raising public awareness of the industry and its career prospects, allowing the next generation to have more options when exploring their career development.

The Day of the Seafarer (25 June) is an important day as recognised by the United Nations as an official observance day. The purpose of the Day, now in its thirteenth year, is to recognise the unique contribution made by seafarers from all over the world to international seaborne trade, the world economy and civil society as a whole.
