marine insurance seems to be an unfamiliar territory to most of us making it difficult to be a priority sector f or young people's career choices

I found Joyce, a marine insurance underwriter to explain what marine insurance is
(Joyce, Marine Insurance Underwriter)

Host: Joyce, what is marine insurance

Joyce: Marine insurance refers to all the marine-related insurance It can be divided into two categories basically Physical loss or damage and liability insurance which is intangible

Joyce: In marine insurance, when it comes to underwriting for multinational corporations or large projects since the insured amount could be huge one single insurance company may not have sufficient underwriting capacity to deal with such huge amount "co-insurance" situation will then arise l.e. cooperation among insurance companies

The interesting part of marine insurance is

your competitors may also be your partners in some large projects
Every case of marine insurance requires
independent analysis and underwriting
You also need to develop tailor-made terms
according to the special requirements of the client

Host: It sounds that the marine insurance industry is really professional If I want to join the industry what should I study?

Joyce: One of the ways is to participate in the trainee programmes provided by the insurance companies or brokers These programmes are designed for those students who have no insurance background I know some exisiting practitioners who entered the industry through trainee programmes and selected the marine insurance industry afterwards Another way is to apply for the junior positions under the marine insurance department of insurance companies Those who have no background in insurance will also be selected for these positions Undoubtedly, if you already have the professional qualifications of the relevant insurance associations you will definitely have an advantage on the on-boarding process Even if you do not have those qualifications they can also be obtained during the training period As long as you are really interested in this industry, work hard and be proactive there are a lot of promotion opportunities in this industry You can achieve a stable development

Host: Joyce, how did you start?

Joyce: In fact, I never thought of engaging in the insurance industry I graduated in the year with undesirable economic condition
There were not many opportunities for fresh graduates
By chance
I came across a non-life insurance broker company
recruiting claims trainees
After understanding the nature of work
I found it interesting and decided to give it a try
Fortunately, they hired me
Then I started my career as a claims trainee

Host: After having been working for a while are there any cases you remembered much of?

Joyce: I remembered a case of a client which is a small and medium sized logistics company Since nobody picked up the goods the goods were detained in another country They did not know how to deal with it Fortunately, the policy terms covered and enabled them to get assistance from lawyers or professionals overseas Later on, the client called us to express their gratitude I think it is joyful to help the clients solve their problems

Host: Those unexpected incidents make them bewildered Fortunately, the professional services provided by you were helpful

Host: What do you think about the prospects for the marine insurance industry?

Joyce: I believe the prospects are positive
Since the marine insurance market is relatively mature in Hong Kong
Hong Kong can play the role of regional insurance
Practitioners of marine insurance in Hong Kong

would have the chance to participate in some regional insurance projects For young people if they do not prefer desk-bound office work but would rather get out of Hong Kong to see and connect to the rest of the world to learn more and are willing to interact with people of different cultures and to better understand other business models the marine insurance industry suits them. It will also provide good development In addition, there is an obvious succession gap in this industry The experienced seniors are willing to provide guidance and support for young people who newly join the industry those who are interested in and are passionate about the industry Once joining, you will find that there are abundant opportunities of self-learning knowledge growth and promotion for them
