# HONG KONG MARITIME WEEK 2021 CLOSED ON AN UPBEAT NOTE

Hong Kong Maritime Week (HKMW) 2021, the city's premier maritime event, was successfully concluded on 6 November. With the staunch support from the industry, a total of 38 activities were organised by 43 local and international maritime bodies during the Week, ranging from conferences, forums, and seminars to visits, competitions, games and tours.

Officiating at the opening ceremony of HKMW 2021, the Chairman of the Hong Kong Maritime and Port Board (HKMPB) and Secretary for Transport and Housing, Mr Chan Fan, Frank, said "Being an international maritime centre, Hong Kong is not immune from global challenges faced by other port cities, particularly the disruptions caused by the pandemic.
